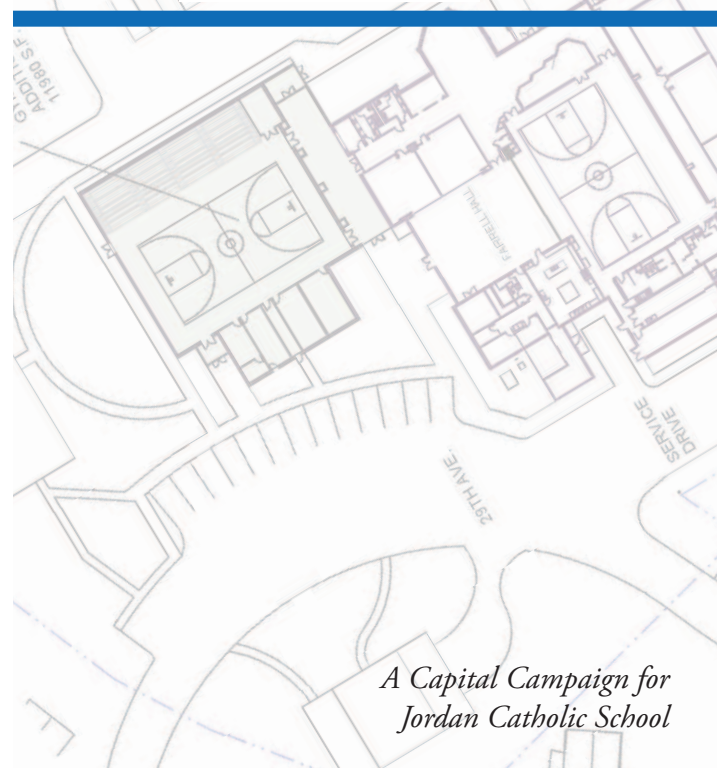

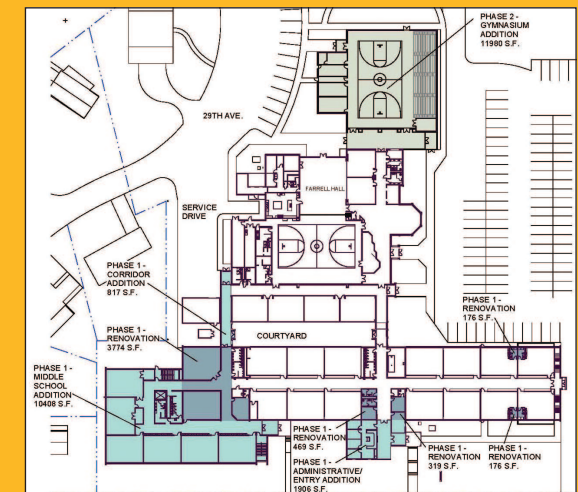
CAMPAIGN PRIORITIES

LIVING OUR MISSION

Jordan Catholic School's mission is to provide students with a Catholic, Christian education resulting in graduates who are committed to the mission of Christ, the Gospel values, and the recognition and development of their individual gifts and abilities. This expansion and renovation plan will positively affect each component of that mission, allowing the school to enhance its educational and spiritual offerings while strengthening Jordan's reputation as one of the finest Catholic schools in the Midwest.

PHASE ONE | \$2.6 million

- 6 new, state-of-the-art classrooms will allow us to teach our students using the most up-to-date technology
- A large, multi-purpose space will accommodate our music program, instrument storage and early childhood physical education
- New science laboratory, centralized computer lab and dedicated classrooms for fine arts and foreign language will enhance our curriculum and the educational opportunities available to Jordan students
- Renovation of former Kindergarten area for an expanded library will allow for more books and additional student workspace
- A new, secure entrance on 24th street will control access to the entire building to keep our children safe.
- Construction of a new corridor will link all classrooms and Farrel Hall as part of a continuous loop.



PHASE TWO | \$2.1 million

- Construction of a gymnasium with a regulation-size, junior high basketball court and retractable seating for 250 people
- New gathering space for school events with access to Farrell Hall and the outdoor patio
- New girls and boys locker rooms
- Expanded parking
