Any registration forms received after this date will not ensure registration and will be charged a \$10.00 late fee. \*Registration has to occur this early to allow time to order shirts and get team pictures into the Jordan Yearbook.

Practices will begin in April and will occur once to twice a week at the coach's discretion. Your daughter's coach will contact you to arrange practice times and locations. Games will begin in May and extend through July, typically once per week, as scheduled by the Moline Dad's Club.

Team photos are scheduled for Friday, February 24 at 3:20pm at Jordan Central in the gym. Pictures for all teams and their coaches will be taken on this date in order of age (Kindergarten is first and so on). New jerseys purchased this year will be passed out on picture day or bring last year's blue jersey for pictures.

Zero Tolerance Policy

Before, during and after the game the following will be enforced:

- ⇒ No player, coach, assistant, parent or spectator shall make insulting or negative remarks, directly or indirectly to or about opposing player, officials, or spectators or commit other acts that could be considered unsportsmanlike.
- ⇒ No player, coach assistant, parent, or spectator shall directly or indirectly make comments to or about the umpiring crew or otherwise badger the umpiring crew.
- ⇒ Umpires will give one warning to a coach or other person(s) for misconduct. Upon the second infraction the coach or person(s) will be ejected from the game site and subject to further disciplinary action. If further misconduct occurs, the game may be forfeited.
- ⇒ Penalty for violating rules of conduct or the no tolerance policy will lead to the temporary or permanent expulsion of anyone involved.
- ⇒ Penalties for violations which occur following a game will be enforced during the next game.
- ⇒ If a problem exists regarding the interpretation of a playing rule the only acceptable means to resolve the problem (before the next pitch) will be for the coach to call time out to calmly discuss the problem with the umpire(s). Following the discussion the umpire(s) will make a ruling and play will continue. If the coach still feels a playing rule has been misinterpreted he should file a protest according to the protest rules.
- ⇒ If there is a physical altercation between a coach, other team representative and an umpire, both are subject to suspension for up to five years, upon review of the commissioner, supervisor of umpires, and The Associated Dad's Club President.
